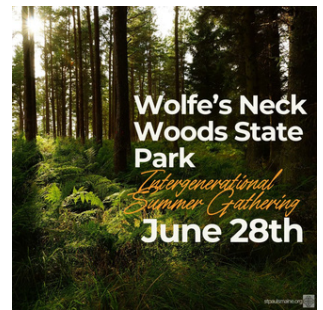
### **June 28th - Wolfe's Neck Woods State Park**
