Circles consist of 6-8 participants and two trained facilitators, and meet together over eleven sessions to discuss films and other materials, creating a space conducive to honest sharing and deep listening. 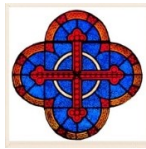
