About 150 people from St. Paul's and the greater Brunswick area have now participated in the Sacred Ground program of conversations about race and racism. The feedback has been that it is an eye-opening and deeply moving experience. Accordingly, we hope to begin several new circles this fall. Circles consist of 6-8 participants and two trained facilitators, and meet together over eleven sessions to discuss films and other materials, creating a space conducive to honest sharing and deep listening. We offer circles both in-person and on Zoom, and we make the schedule based on participant availability. Sacred Ground is for anyone who wants to understand racism more clearly and envision how we might move forward in a different way. Please join us!

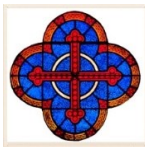
