*You may...*

- 1. Receive communion in "one kind" - consecrated bread only or consecrated wine only. In the Episcopal Church, receiving in one kind is considered full communion. If you would like consecrated gluten free bread, please place your hands facing down.*
- 2. Drink from the common cup.*
- 3. Cross hands over chest after receiving the bread and the Chalice Bearer will say, "the blood of Christ" but will not distribute the wine. Please help the Lay Eucharistic Ministers by choosing one of these three options. **Please do not dip the wafer into the chalice.***
